## **EVERYONE NEEDS TO BE CAREFUL OF A FALSE SALVATION!**

Mat 6:33 But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Salvation deception will be evident if one is not able to walk after the Spirit and there is no apparent change in one's life!

No desire to learn more and more about God's will and way for this life! A false comfort comes from a false salvation!

Rom 8:1 *There is* therefore now no condemnation <u>to them</u> which are <u>in</u> Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Rom 8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

- Rom 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; **but** they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.
- Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
- Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

Rom 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Rom 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, <u>if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you</u>. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

Please examine your life and make sure you have not been deceived! True peace comes from God Almighty!

Psa 26:2 Examine me, O LORD, and prove me; try my reins and my heart.

2Co 13:5 Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?

## A FEW WORDS DEFINED:

DOCILITY - Teachableness; readiness to learn; aptness to be taught.

TO'WARD - TO'WARDLINESS - Readiness to do or learn; aptness; docility.

**FAITH** - Saving faith, is the assent of the mind to the truth of divine revelation, on the authority of God's testimony, accompanied with a cordial assent of the will or approbation of the heart; an entire confidence or trust in God's character and declarations, and in the character and doctrines of Christ, with an unreserved surrender of the will to his guidance, and dependence on his merits for salvation. In other words, that firm belief of God's testimony, and of the truth of the gospel, which influences the will, and leads to an entire reliance on Christ for salvation.

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Heb 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Don't be deceived, a person can repent of sin without turning toward God! (Many are sorry for results of sin in their life, but few are willing to turn completely to God and His Word for complete faith and practice! – Deception!) Most people are completely willing to have a lawyer help them escape or reduce the penalty for being caught in some crime/sin, but one has to completely trust in the system to escape any other charges. Since all people are sinners by birth and sinners by choice, we are unable to escape judgment without an eternal advocate, Jesus Christ!

If you have never sincerely turned toward God and accepted His plan of redemption, Jesus' shed blood on the cross for the sins of the whole world, His resurrection from the dead, testifying of His power and ability to save your soul from your sin, please do not hesitate!

Act 20:21 Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ.

Act 16:31 ".....Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house."
